Description: By clicking and dragging a mouse on a Quicktime Virtual Reality (QTVR) movie, the viewer can navigate around a visual scene at will. Linking several QTVR movies together that are referenced by a map can provide interactive tours of buildings and facilities as well as educational spaces in museums and schools.

This presentation will provide a tutorial including the creation of a QTVR panorama movie, a QTVR object movie and the linking of movies for the purpose of creating interactive content.
